I urgently wish to add the following in response to Issue 1 of the TCEQ Sunset Commission Staff Report: In addition to making public meetings meaningful early in the permit application process, the permit application Notice and Signage requirements must be strengthened. * SIGNAGE

REQUIREMENT: Within three days of TCEQ accepting an application for a TCEQ permit, the applicant at applicant's expense must place prominent, visible signage at the points of maximum public view on the physical location designated in the application. The signage will clearly display the future use described in the permit, with TCEQ and applicant contact information. The applicant shall upload photographic evidence to the publicly displayed TCEQ Commissioners' Integrated Database, or equivalent, of timely and fully meeting the signage requirements. The signage shall remain well maintained in place until the conclusion of the permit process. * NOTICE REQUIREMENT: Within three days of TCEQ accepting an application for a TCEQ permit, TCEQ shall send via registered U.S. Mail plain language information clearly describing the application to all surrounding property owners for a distance of at least two miles from the center of the physical location designated in the application. The applicant shall bear the expense of this TCEQ notification to the surrounding property owners.
