Some of my main concerns are TCEQ not doing a proper job, especially in protecting our communities, bays, and estuaries from the dangers of pollution. Recently they gave permission to Cheniere to chuff out some 353 tons per year of VOCs, double the limit set out in its original permit eight years ago. The state raised limits on four other pollutants by more than 40%. How did it suddenly become safer? Was new research produced by credible scientists that took into account the cumulative impact of climate change, which they are now legally obligated to do under the Biden Administration, into making these changes that affect the health and well being of our home and community members?!?
