- 3. It's all over my clothes and shows.
- 4. my wife gets exposed to it when she does the laundry.
- 5. It's nasty and unhealthy.
- 6. In all the years I've worked around these plants, I have NEVER seen it being monitored.
- 7. 440 yds distance should not include the affected person's property. The 440 yds. Should be the minimum distance that a cement plant should be from other people's property including the state's property and roadways, and parks, schools, etc.
