This report vindicates the issues I raised while working in the IT department at TWC.

I believe my termination resulted from investigating those serious issues and the EEO complaint I filed, not from the mischaracterizations of my protected activity, whistleblowing and other allegations they used to "justify" my termination.

I asked for a name clearing hearing to remove the false claims from my public personnel file and they refused, which is illegal, by the way. Gov employees have a right to a name-clearing hearing.

I had hoped they would finally acknowledge the exculpatory evidence I provided regarding the claims they made about me and bring me back under different leadership, but they are stonewalling.

I'm not sure that the OGC and IT leadership is even being honest with the commissioners about my case. I can't imagine the commissioners wouldn't act to solve this issue if they knew all the facts.

Now it's going to end up being a public relations nightmare as my only recourse appears to be the media and litigation.
