Your Comments or Concerns

As organizer for the Personal Attendant Coalition of Texas, we continue getting complaints about agencies that go bankrupt and don't pay attendants what they are owed. Soon after, the same people that were managing those agencies, open up a new agency with a different name and continued doing business as usual. We have become aware of at least five agencies that have conducted businesses this way. We have at least 50 plus cases from the attendant workforce that have been brought to our attention in regard to these issues. Placing complaints has become a mute issue due to the fact that nothing gets resolved.

Your Proposed Solution

When an agency applies to open up their business, we recommend that proof of sufficient economic solvency be provided so that in case of an emergency or potential bankruptcy, the attendant workforce doesn't have to pay the collateral damage of business mismanagement. We also recommend that the provider agencies be required to obtain some type of insurance that covers all worker hours that have been worked up to the date of notice that the provider is no longer an employee of such agency.

Another recommendation is to not allow individuals to obtain a permit to open up another agency under a different name until all issues from the previous agency have been resolved, including unpaid work hours for their attendants.
