Whenever an APRN is under disciplinary investigation, the majority of those doing the investigating should be APRNs in the same specialty area who are familiar with the APRN's scope of practice. In order to ensure a fair and impartial process of any peer review or disciplinary proceeding, it is important to require the involvement of APRNs peers for cases that call into question APRN practice issues. For example, I am a Certified Nurse Midwife in private practice. I see my own patients and deliver their babies in their homes. If I get called before the Board for review, it's very important that those reviewing the case be familiar with Nurse Midwifery and out-of-hospital practice.
