Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed:

I am a physical therapist and have been practicing in Bedford, TX for the past 10 months, as I have graduated from PT school in May 2015, and am currently representing only myself as a Physical Therapy professional. I am in support for the Sunset Commission's recommendation for the Texas Board of Physical Therapy Examiners to join the national Licensure Compact, as it would allow for PTs such as myself, and/or PTAs to be able to work in differing states and not have to be postponed / delayed by being involved with individual state licensure requirements. PTs/PTAs should have the ability to quickly relocate and provide their services as soon as possible to provide the best customer service to their client base. In addition, most PTs/PTAs would have the incentive to relocate to where they are needed the most and not be delayed with additional requirements.

In addition, CCAP should be allowed to continue to function under the TPTA to work with the TBTPE and continue their collaborative process, rather than be relocated. This is a processes that has been working well in the past and should continue undisrupted as it run as a separate program from the TPTA's professional association activities, and does not present as any kind of special preference as such.
