Opposed: I am opposed to the recommendation listed under Issue 3 to

abolish the limited medical radiologic technologist certification. Limited radiologic technologist program includes 900 hours of classroom training and

600 hours of in the field training with direct patient care. The training received by LMRT's is much more in depth than the 120 hour training received by NCT's. LMRT's are also required to complete 12 hours of continuing education every 2 years, this is not a requirement for NCT's.
