I support all 7 recommendations:

1. Rename licensure from "Licensed Specialist in School Psychology (LSSP)" to "School Psychologist"
  - I feel as though the LSSP title does not represent what we actual do but separates us from others in the mental health field.
2. Proportionate Representation of LSSPs on TSBEP
  - We are a truly unique profession and the more differences and perspectives brought to the mental health table the better.
3. Allow LSSPs to practice in private schools
  - A school is a school, whether it be public or private children will have disabilities.
4. Align State Law and Regulation for Practice to Reflect National Standards for the Practice of School Psychology
  - Its important for our State Regulations for Practice to Relfect National Standards for Practice so that that we can develop a better consistency in our profession. Consistency will cultivate better practice.
5. LSSPs must have a conferred degree in School Psychology or a Re-Specialization Certification from a School Psychology Program
6. Maintain the Texas State Board of Examiners of Psychologists

7. Remove the Prohibition of LSSPs Ability to Practice in Private Clinics
