Opposed: I strongly support the repeal of the referral requirement for PT treatment. As a new graduate physical therapist who was raised and completed her DPT in Texas, I feel the amount of education we complete is undermined by this referral requirement. As a result, I have decided to pursue a residency outside the state of Texas and will move to Ohio, where the state practice act allows physical therapists to perform treatments without a referral. In many cases, a physician's referral simply states something broad such as "shoulder plan, evaluate and treat." Allowing patients to have greater access to physical therapy increases their independence in making decisions regarding their healthcare and decreases costs. Additionally, Texas risks losing many well-qualified and trained physical therapists to other states if the state practice act fails to improve.
