Subject: Re: A year is approaching with zero results and no help.

We have sent/left multiple messages and emails with ZERO response from TMB. I'm contacting you again, because if the TMB analyst read the documents that she requested, which was a police report, case file & a written statement from my lawyer, she would see there was no charges & the case was dismissed. The analyst (Glenette Reid) has had my file for months, states that I need to appear before the board but allowed me to miss the board meeting in October. (The meeting was called to order 10/7/2016 at 9:45 a.m. by Chair, Latana Jackson-Woods, RCT. Committee members present were Joe Ann Clack, Timothy Chappell, M.D. and Debra Patrick RRT RCP.) I started this application in February 2016. I contacted the board chairman Latana Jackson- Woods and she informed me that a vote was reached to have files like mine emailed to her in order to process applications, due to the board members only meeting a few times per year. I asked Glenette, my analyst to forward my file to Latana Jackson and she refuses. That vote is legally binding, yet I'm being denied that right, according to Robert's Law, TMB should have all of their employees including their analyst on the same page following their votes and is stated on the TMB website of "rules and laws" adopted by the RCP division. This case on my file is almost 20yrs old. I'm attaching multiple TMB staff members in hopes that someone will respond, thus far nobody has.
Below is a message that was sent on 12/6/2016 at 1302, it's now 12/18/2016 2321 and no staff members have responded. Attached is a copy of the proposed rules from the TMB website.

Good afternoon, I have contacted Latana Jackson-Woods the RCP chairman and she has stated that a vote from the RCP (respiratory therapy) board has been reached in order to move applicants along, to have files emailed to the board members, Mrs. Jackson stated that Mr. Flores's file can be sent to her via email and that all applicants have to resubmit a new application and a "WAR" is granted and the analyst can offer a WAR.
