**REQUEST IMMEDIATE CLOSURE OF
CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES**

Dear Representatives:

Our agency has become involved with the legislature since 2007 and nothing has been done to protect our parents and children. We oppose all and any recommendations regarding Child Protective Services. None of the recommendations are targeted to help our parents and our children. These recommendations are recommendations that have been suggested for years and the recommendations have failed to make Child Protective Services a “functional agency.” In Texas alone, there are 3,059 children deceased while they children were in the custody of Child Protective Services, foster homes and state agencies! 29,775 children lingering in Child Protective Services with more added daily!

It’s time for change and it’s time to “abolish Child Protective Services.

Time and time again, we have testified against Child Protective Services and our suggestions have been met with a negative response.

We have heard agencies/families testify against Child Protective Services and have witnessed account after account of the “horrifying” experiences children are exposed to while in Child Protective Services, state agencies and foster homes and nothing is done!

We also have given each and every one of you information packets and have presented information as to why Child Protective Services has failed. We have made recommendations/suggestions and nothing has been put into action and our requests have been ignored regarding the immediate closure of Child Protective Services.

Seems to me, that the senators and representatives are ignoring the facts. Time and time again, all these politician’s focus is “more staff and more funding,” and this has been done for years! **We are sick and tired of the same ideas being offered each year which has not made a positive impact on Child Protective Services.**

Attached are pictures of dead children, the most recent, "Colton Turner," which was Protected to Death by Child Protective Services. You and Child Protective Services "Murdered" these children!

These dead children are the result of "Worker Error/Mistake. " Incompetent CPS workers/manager/supervisors," who cannot distinguish "signs" of physical abuse!

These workers take children away from parents when there is "no sign of abuse" and when a child is abuse and has signs of abuse, the CPS worker leaves the child in the home.

Attached is the case of Ms. Vicki Valverde (see attached) which is self-explanatory. In this case, Child Protective Services wanted to removed, my grandson, just because he made an outcry, which was false and when the worker investigated, he witness, my grandson, with no physical abuse and/or bruises and the work was very rude and threatening to Ms. Valverde.

I contacted Mr. Specia, who did nothing and this case is still open since December 2013. APPALLING!!! Something serious with this picture! Waste of taxpayer money! This case is one of many!!

It is obvious, that you, are not doing your job in protecting our families and children with more families and children dying each year. The most recent "Colton Turner.

The other core of the problem is that CPS is rewarded for every child that it removes! Which serves as an incentive for CPS to keep/remove children. CPS + CHILDREN = \$157,000 EV 3 YRS!!

This funding has given CPS "coercive power" and has allowed CPS to victimize our families and children!!!

YOUR ACTIONS ARE APPALLING AND YOUR DECISIONS HAVE ALLOWED CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES TO MURDER OUR CHILDREN!!!!!!
