Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed:

I strongly oppose the closing of any State Supported Living Centers (SSLC)

The argument to close SSLCs in favor of private care facilities need to consider:

- Clients in private facilities would have to provided the same individualized care plans as they receive in the SSLCs.
- With closure of SSLCs the private facilities would multiply exponentially.

Inspections of these additional hundreds of, if not thousands of, facilities would have to be frequent and thorough. A large number of inspectors would have to be trained to carry out the inspections. Punishment for violations would have to be swift and severe which I am sure would result in court cases the state would have to pay for.

- The transition would take years and be painful. Taking clients out of the structured SSLCs could be very traumatic to certain individuals.
- Adding to the transition time would be training time for the private care workers. I would recommend these workers have to go through state provided training courses and then be individually licensed. The license would then have to be renewed yearly.
- It is my understanding Private Care Facilities' costs do not reflect Medical services provided and paid for by Medicaid. The Commission needs to research this claim and reevaluate the data!
