Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed: I am opposed to any staff that is able to make rules or pass laws affecting an individual's personal rights and in some cases their lively hood. The Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Part 10, Chapter 217, Subchapter A. Rule 217.3 is one ridiculous example of over reach in Texas. The TXDMV abilities to refuse, revoke or suspend a title or not allowing titling of a vehicle the department deems unsafe without research, discussion or notification is absurd. The members of the general public are adversely affected by this process it would be proper for the commission to provide the necessary assistance to investigate decisions or rulings made by the staff of TXDMV Licensing.

Any Alternative or New Recommendations on This Agency:

- 1) Reinstate the title and registration of those vehicles that had executed the proper inspection and title registration process that were previously approved by the department.
- 2) Amend Texas Administrative Rules: Title 43, Part 10, Chapter 217, Subchapter A, Rule §217.3 to delete (6) (A) and (B) Not Eligible for Title and amend (C) by deleting "or determined by the department" and (D) by deleting "or determined by the department"
- 3) Assemble a Vehicle Coalition interested in assisting the department in its desire to clarify the process for appealing the department's decision to refuse, revoke or suspend a title. Since the members of the general public are adversely affected by this process it would be proper for the Coalition to provide the necessary assistance where applicable.
