New Recommendations:

Our licensure should be renamed from "Licensed Specialist in School Psychology to School Psychologist". This will better define and simplify our position and make it less confusing to parents, educators, and to the community in general. It would also make our title consistent with other states.

Ensure proportionate representation of LSSPs on the TSBEP for fair and appropriate representation

Allow LSSPs to practice in private schools to allow these students access to mental health services in schools, as well

Ensure that LSSPs have a conferred degree in School Psychology or Re-Specialization Certification Program for appropriate training requirements for those providing psychological services for children in schools

Remove the Prohibition of LSSPs ability to Practice in Private Clinics in order to provide increased access to mental health services to children
