My name is Amy Hall, and I am a physical therapist currently practicing in acute care at Baylor Irving Medical Center. I have practiced in the state of Texas for 6 months. I am writing to support the Sunset Commission's recommendation that the Texas Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (TBPTE) join the national Licensure Compact. This arrangement would allow licensure across state lines and facilitate the ability of PT's and PTA's to move from state to state without having to jump through state licensure obstacles and delay the process.
