Opposed: I am opposed to the proposed sunset of the Instructors license in the cosmetology and barber programs. I have been a licensed cosmetology instructor for 15 years and Teaching students isn't just about showing them how to do a specific skill. The instructor training teaches how to facilitate an effective classroom learning environment by learning subjects in learning styles, classroom management, lesson planning, and presentation skills, It is an EXPECTATION when you are hired as a cosmetology instructor especially at a high school and college level that you know how to facilitate a class and submit lesson plans. I worked 7 years behind the chair before I decided to go school to be an instructor and I Knew nothing about learning types and how to lesson plan or present using a lesson plan. Getting the Instructors training and license gave me the confidence and ability to work as a cosmetology instructor In both the private and public school systems.

Sunsetting the cosmetology Instructor program would force public high schools and colleges into requiring A degree in education to ensure faculty have basic teaching skills in the classroom.
