My name is Dr. Jeff Killion and I am the chair of the Radiologic Science programs at Midwestern State University. I have been reading the Sunset May 2014 report and have some concerns. If the recommendation is to move the state licensure of Medical Radiologic Technologists under a different office/department that would be a viable option. But if the recommendation is for the state to discontinue state licensure of Medical Radiologic Technologist this would be an immense mistake. Radiologic Technologist do have national certification BUT it is voluntary – not required, it is up to the individual states to have licensure to require individuals to have the proper certification and education to administer radiation to the public.
