

## **What Sunset Commissioners Can Do to Protect Texas from Radioactive Waste Dumping from around the Country**

- **Ask the Compact Commission to halt the vote on the Import/Export rule.**

The Comment period ends Dec. 26<sup>th</sup> and the Compact Commission needs more time to analyze citizen comment.

The Compact Commission *may try to meet as early as January 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>*, and possibly outside of Austin.

- **Why? Texas Legislators need time to analyze the financial and environmental risks for the state risks of expanding to take waste from around the country.**

The Compact Agreement was intended to limit waste to the Compact states, which today are only Texas and Vermont.

- **Other states should get Congressional approval to join the Compact and pay their fair share. Vermont will pay \$25 million and while Texas pays \$100 million.**
