I OPPOSE the Sunset Staff recommendation to abolish the Licensed Breeders Program. The last thing my community of Houston and Harris County needs are more unregulated puppy mills that contribute a huge number of dogs to our already overwhelmed Animal Welfare system. Our public shelters are overfilled and costing taxpayers millions of dollars.
