Another aspect are those entities, such as low cost, high volume spay and neuter clinics that provide a service to the community where they are located

- daily logging of individual doses of ketamine used in anesthetic protocols for 60+ individual patients daily would require additional staffing and cost thus requiring an increase in price to the general public - this would have a negative impact on the work these organization have done to help reduce the pet population via these low-cost/affordable spay/neuter programs as well as negatively reflect on the veterinary industry overall as being "greedy" and a perceived overcharging when the general public does not understand all the true costs involved with practicing veterinary medicine and the associated regulations.
