I am writing also to address Management Action, Issue 3, 3.8, LPC.

I am a Texas certified school counselor of eighteen years, with bachelor's degree and master's degree from Texas universities. I have participated in multiple (50+, probably more) counseling conferences and trainings, counseled children, teenagers, and parents, and conducted many psycho educational groups and trainings. I am currently completing a 16-semester hour post-graduate Certification in Mental Health Counseling from another Texas university, with a second supervised internship/practicum in a mental health setting where I hope to continue. I have completed one national exam successfully and have two more exams to complete. Once requirements are completed, I can apply for LPC-Intern (Licensed Professional Counselor) and am required 3,000 supervised hours before becoming licensed. While I firmly believe LPC's should be educated in their field and qualified, I am concerned about the length of LPC internship supervision hours required (especially for those with multiple years of experience). On top of the extensive hour requirements of internship, not to mention the administrative aspect, there is financial cost for the lengthy supervision.
