I have been a licensed plumber in the State of Texas for over 45 years and have proudly installed/repaired plumbing for those 45 years. I have been a Responsible Master Plumber for 43 years. Doing away with testing and licensing will only lessen the value of our license, possibly put homeowners and business owners at risk by having plumbers who are not qualified. Saving money is great, but not at the expense of our environment, homes, businesses and people's lives. I feel the State Board of Plumbing Examiners should ultimately be in control of testing and licensing of plumbers, not the TDLR.
