Opposed: I strongly oppose dismantling the TSBPE. TSBPE has been doing a great job protecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of our great state. They are a government agency that returns their phone calls and emails in a timely fashion, unlike other state boards I have dealt with in the past. The TSBPE requests every year for more funding because of the growth they have experienced and continued to have the funding requests disapproved. The board sends millions of dollars to the general fund every year that could easy fund improvements needed to protect the citizens of Texas. If no one is out policing the plumbing industry then anyone could call themselves "a plumber" which is not good for our citizens.
