Opposed: I am very much opposed any suggestion in the staff report that might lead to the abolishment of the Texas Holocaust and Genocide Commission (THGC).

Any Alternative or New Recommendations on This Agency: I recommend that the THGC not only continue but that its budget be increased. In 2019 the Texas legislature mandated that Texas schools find ways to observe Holocaust Remembrance Week. The THGC has been instrumental in seeing to it that the mandate--the law--be followed; does the state wants its law to be followed?

The THGC is the only body at the state government level that has among its members specialists--published scholars--not only on the Holocaust and genocide but also on antisemitism and racism. Will the state turn its back on these increasingly pressing issues?
