Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed: Staff report is absolutely off. The Texas Medical Board is absolutely a thug organization.

I am writing in absolute disbelief at how the Texas Medical Board operates as a whole.

I speak directly to the case of Dr. Calvin Day v Texas Medical Board.

I witnessed the autocratic dismantling of a 28 year Medical career, the unemployment of 28 Nurses, Medical assistants and office staff and the Medical displacement of over 10,000 skin cancer patients in the time it took to receive a 20 page fax suspending his license.

Without Due Process, without the ability to defend himself (all accusations, charges and complaints have been dismissed in a court of law), and with the utter disregard for the well being of the patients.

Dr. Day was the first MOHS surgeon in San Antonio and taught MOHS at the University of Texas Medical School in San Antonio. At the time of his unfounded suspension, Dr. Day was one of three MOHS Dermatologist in the city seeing patients from all over South Texas. Needless to say, these actions caused significant turmoil for these patients including missed diagnosis by overwhelmed doctors trying to pick up the slack.

The staff, most of whom were single mothers and the sole providers for their families, are still trying to recover financially. A number have been forced into bankruptcy.

All of this occurred because a single, malicious patient, with a long history of extortion attempts, slip and fall law suits, insurance claims and outright fraud, decided she would accuse Dr. Day of sexually misconduct. Without evidence and with questionable police involvement (the DA and prosecutors office have been reprimanded for

misconduct and suppression of evidence) and with a Texas Medical Board Staff Attorney suppression evidence as well (noted in the TMB case file) suspended Dr. Day's license without a hearing.

Now that Dr. Day has been fully exonerated, the Texas Medical Board has yet to reinstate Dr. Day and may not do so.

How is the Texas Medical Board allowed to act as an Autocratic Dictator destroying lives and how is the staff attorney still working after suppressing evidence that would have assisted Dr. Day and his case. Further more, the staff attorney is making statements on public Web portals that he/she believes Dr. Day is guilty and that he got off on a technicality. How can the Texas Medical Board allow such malicious tactics which I believe border on Defamation. And how does this individual still maintain integrity.

As a whole, I am exceedingly disappointed in the Texas Medical Board and those that allow this Totalitarian Type of board to exist.
