Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed: I have read the various reports related to the San Jacinto River Authority. I could not find any mention in the report that identifies SJRA's complete lack of appropriate evaluation of information related to the part that Lake Conroe plays with regard to local/area flooding. More pointedly, the LACK of impact that Lake Conroe plays in local/area flooding. This is clearly a significant problem with SJRA's ability to properly evaluate technical data. In my opinion, the only conclusion the public can make is that SJRA lacks staff with the appropriate training or SJRA simply choose what data they want to ignore. This is truly a serious problem that Texas Government and Governance seem to not want to correct.

Any Alternative or New Recommendations on This Agency: Provide a board made up of private citizens selected by the local state representatives of the area. Have that board provide oversight to ensure that SJRA properly evaluates and funds the necessary reports to develop trust across all impacted parties.
