Although there have been some problems, for the most of the past 40 years he has been very happy there and has been well cared for.

He works at the Center Work Shop and is very proud of doing a good job. The staff says he is a good worker. He takes pride in the job he does.

We have visited group homes in the past and none have been anything like the Center, none had work options suited to Lynn as the Center has. There are many problems with group homes that do not seem to make the news like some small problems at a State Supported Living Center.

We feel the staff does a great job and the home is always so very clean and livable.

We know there are expenses to the Centers but we do hope you and the other people on the Sunset Advisory Commission will consider leaving the Lubbock Center open as it has been such a great place for Lynn.
