Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed: I cannot believe you would seek to do away with licensing of medical radiologic technologists. Great harm can be done when people that are unlicensed perform radiologic procedures. You say that you cannot prevent that harm in your report. You can and do greatly reduce the chance of that harm being done by requiring people to be educated and licensed to perform these procedures. Why do you not seek to remove licensing from nurses?
