Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed: I disagree on the report recommending the removal of the licensure, certification, or registration of the Code Enforcement professions or practices. Code Enforcement works for the health, safety, and welfare of the public which is what THSD represents.
