Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed:

Opposed: I oppose the recommendation by the Sunset Advisory Commission to no longer have Code Officers certified, licensed and regulated by the State. The continuing education hours for a Registered Code Officer are already limited.

By the State eliminating the requirement will only limit the profession further. The code officer will be limited to only the ordinance in his or her municipality, hindering any re-location is the code officer choices.

Furthermore smaller municipalities may be subject to legal actions due to lack of knowledge of the interruption of the codes from an un-license code officer.
