Your Comments About the Staff Report, Including Recommendations Supported or Opposed:

I am in OPPOSITION to Recommendation 3.2 because it places the public at risk. The regulatory oversight provided by the Texas State Board of Examiners of Marriage and Family Therapists which includes licensed marriage and family therapist as well as public members ensures that all LMFTs are well trained and adhere to high professional standards. The impact of LMFTs on the health and safety of clients they serve mandates the oversight of an independent regulatory board that includes experienced licensed professionals.

Unlike the other professions recommended for transfer to the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation in Recommendation 3.2, Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists, Professional Counselors and Social Workers must hold advanced graduate degrees and are considered Health Professional under Texas law. None of the occupations currently licensed by TDLR are required to hold even a bachelors degree.
